

Town Board Meeting Minutes
From May 11th 2026

Called to order at 6:30 pm

Trevor made a motion to approve the minutes from April 13th town board meeting, Shawn seconded. All in favor.

Residents address town board:

Cedric asked about the brush/tree cutting at the intersection on Camp Rd. and County Hwy X wondering if the town board talked with the land owners Kim or Darrell about cutting on the corner. Marathon County will not do anything with it due to it not being in their right of way. Cedric suggested the town talk with the land owners. Shawn will talk with the land owners about cutting the corner for better visibility.

Swatloski quote for ditching on Cisewski road and culvert removal, installation, and labor cost.

Trevor made a motion to have Swatloski remove and install the culverts, Shawn 2nd the motion all in favor.

Transportation Resolution Clerk and Chairman signed

Conditional use permit/Z-Place 2B

Question was raised about the right away and the fence being located in the right away. The Town Board will approve the material and height of the fencing. They will not approve the placement of the fencing as this is Marathon County's right of way.

Shawn made a motion to approve the conditional use permit with the verbiage of placement being in the right of way. Trevor 2nd the motion, all in favor.

Construction signs:

Trevor made a motion to approve road signs and stands order, Shawn 2nd the motion all in favor.

Steve will order 2 men working, 2 road closed, and 2 stands.

Unpaid taxes: A few delinquent taxes have been paid. There are less than 5 unpaid past due taxes for the Town of Guenther
